Parent Financial Contribution 2020

Dear Parents,

In the preparation of the Annual Program Budgets, three key financial resources are carefully considered. These are: Department of Education and Training Grants, locally raised funds and financial contributions from parents.

School Council is most appreciative of the high level of support that the school received from parents in 2019.

For 2020 the Financial Contribution from parents for a child's education at Herne Hill Primary School will be \$240 per child. This \$240.00 payment consists of the following:

(A) Essential Student Learning Items: \$160.00
The Department of Education and Training approved payment which includes the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Paper /student work books etc.2. All stationery-for individual students.3. Equipment for Visual Arts, Performing Arts, English, Mathematics, LOTE, Integrated, Studies, Science, PE, Photography, Technology, Mathematics, and Life Education.4. Internet access.5. Photocopying and printing costs <p>The majority of student requisites are purchased in bulk at the beginning of the year by the school, and then issued throughout the year as needed.</p>
(B) Extra-Curricular Activities: \$80.00 (Bulk payment)
Each semester all children are involved in major and minor excursions plus access to visiting groups when the opportunity arises. The bulk payment for excursions has contributed to much greater efficiency for staff organising excursions and reduced the pressure on young children being asked for payment <u>before</u> each activity.
(C) Voluntary Financial Contributions: \$50 or \$20 or another amount of your choice
Families are invited to contribute a voluntary payment for the following area: Computer/ Technology Replacement Program A donation of either \$20, \$50 or another amount per child/family to ensure that Herne Hill Primary School stays up to date with technology. We ask that families please support this initiative, which has been developed to ensure we maintain our information technology equipment at the highest level, including Computers, Classroom IPADs, Classroom screens, 3D Printing and Multimedia devices across all Learning Communities. <i>(Please note that this is not a tax-deductible item).</i>

Health Care/ Pension Card ONLY:

Health Care Card Holders/Pensioners can also claim the \$80 per child for Excursions under the **Camps, Sports Excursion Fund (CSEF)**. The total amount of this fund is \$125 which leaves \$45.00 in credit towards swimming, camps/visiting artists etc.

School Council has carefully considered the setting of the level of financial contributions being requested from parents and has endeavored to keep the total amount as low as possible, without compromising the level of resourcing being made available to the students.

The opportunity for parents to pay one instalment of \$240 or two Instalments of \$120.00 is available. We request that full payment of the 2020 Financial Contribution be made by **Friday 27th March 2020**.

OR

If you wish to pay in instalments the first instalment by **Friday 27th March 2020** and the second instalment by **Friday 26th June 2020**.

Please Note: Not included in these charges are the following extra-curricula expenses:

Grade P-4 Swimming	\$ 45.00 (approximately)
Grade 2 sleepover	\$ 15.00
Interschool sports (bus and registration)	\$ per event
iPad purchase (2020 Grade 3 students only)	\$ POA (you can pay off throughout the year)
Camp 3-4	\$ 250 approximately
Camp 5-6	\$ \$300

(Approximate costs based on 2019 figures are provided as a guide).

REGULAR PART & PRE PAYMENTS

Making regular payments can greatly assist parents with spreading payment costs throughout the year. It may be as little as \$5 a week! Any spare money can be put on your account at any time. For example, you may wish to make small prepayments for the swimming program from the beginning of the year even though swimming is held later in the year. Prepayments can be made by the following payment options:

Centrepay

The easy way to pay your bills and expenses. Centrepay is a voluntary bill-paying service that is free for Centrelink customers. Use Centrepay to arrange regular Deductions from your Centrelink payment. You can start or change a Deduction at any time. The quickest way to do it is through your Centrelink account online.

BPay

Payment made directly to the school by using your Bpay Biller Code and Reference No. This can be done as once off or regular payments.

Either call into the office, or contact us and we'll send your statement home (*The statement contains your Bpay codes*).

Cash, EFTPOS, Credit Card or Cheque

Cash or cheques are paid directly to the office or in an envelope. EFTPOS machine is also available at the office.

Payment envelopes are available at the office for use. Payment can be made over the phone using your credit card.
